## Andrzej Kraśnicki - The President of the Polish Olympic Committee

AT THE 2009 SCHOOLS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN QATAR, AS MANY AS 5 WORLD RECORDS WERE SET BY POLAND'S REPRESENTATIVES, SUCH AS KLAUDIANAZIĘBŁO AND MARCIN CIEŚLAK, WHO ARE NOW PART OF THE POLISH SENIORS TEAM. IS PARTICIPATION IN SUCH EVENTS A GOOD WAY FOR YOUNG SWIMMERS TO GO ON IN THE FUTURE AND REPRESENT THEIR COUNTRY AND TAKE PARTFOR INSTANCE IN THE OLYMPIC GAMES?

- Sport at school is the best possible opportunity for development in this area of life. My dream is for Poland to have as many sports schools as possible, which would focus not only on sports, but also on preparing students for their future careers, once their sports careers are over. School sports form the basis of physical development in general, so I'm glad that here in Poznan, I'm witnessing an event that brings together students talented in swimming and where one can compare the results of such schools from different countries. Of course it is very important for this development to be harmonious and for them to reach their peak form in their senior sports age. I believe that professional trainers and teachers have much experience in this area and know how to go about it.

WE ARE TALKING TODAY AT THE BEAUTIFUL MODERN RECREATIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX "TERMY MALTAŃSKIE". DOES THE POLISH OLYMPIC COMMITTEE HAVE FURTHER PLANS WITH REGARD TO THIS FACILITY IN THE FUTURE?

- The "Termy Maltańskie" complex is a subject particularly close to my heart, because it was thanks to funds and through decisions taken by the Polish Sport Confederation, of which I am chairman, that the sports facilities of this complex were built. So you could say I am one of its co-founders and its operations are very important to me. At the same time, as President of the Polish Olympic Committee, I cannot imagine further development of our Olympic water sports, such as swimming, diving and synchronized swimming without this unique facility here in Poznan.

Otylia Jędrzejczak - champion of the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, champion and three times world record holder, European champion and record holder, and three times elected best Polish athlete.
DID YOUR SWIMMING CAREER BEGIN LIKE THESE SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPANTS, MEANING WITH COMPETITIONS FOR STUDENTS?

- I must admit that I remember very little about school competitions, except to say that in my youth they weren't held very often. I learnt, trained and prepared for competitions mainly in my school and at a club, and then pretty soon "jumped" to representation level and started competing with the best in the world. It's rather a shame really, because I think that school age is the best time to establish international connections and make friends for life. I began to have such contacts with colleagues from other countries a little later, at the junior age. But those have survived to this day, because we have been meeting up at various sporting events for many years now. So I believe that such interschool competitions as this in Poznan are wonderful moments in life and a chance that must be used to establish international connections. Of course, all the students who have come here no doubt have their own dreams, challenges and sports-related goals. Swimming as a career robs one a little of one's childhood, but in return it gives one fortitude and determination, and teaches consistency, the rules of fair play and respect for others, values that remain for the rest of one's life. If in a few days time everyone leaves Poznan with the attitude that they had a good time and were able to make new friends, they will remember this event for years to come.
WHICH SWIMMING STYLE DID YOU BEGIN WITH, WHICH OF THEM DID YOU PARTICULARLY LIKE, AND WHICH IF ANY CAUSED YOU PROBLEMS?
- In the beginning the hardest for me was diving from the starting board, but my breaststroke was pretty good and in the to 12 age category, I was even the Polish record holder. Strangely enough later, in my senior career, this was the worst style for me, my Achilles heel... There has never been any one style that I particularly loved, but each had something I liked, including diving.

Name: Dragon Boat Race Festival for competitors of the World Schools Swimming Championship Date: 20.04.2015 (Monday), 9.30-11.30. Place: MALTA Regatta Course Poznań (3 Wiankowa Street)


Competition rules
1.300 people will participate in the competition.
2. The participants start in ten-man boats.
3. The participants will be assigned to boats by means of a draw. Prior to the beginning of the competition, each participant will be assigned by the Organizing Committee of the World Schools Swimming Championship to a particular crew. Crews will be distinguished by stickers with numbers worn in a visible place on their suits.
4. All participants are required to wear a life jacket.
5. The regatta will take place over a distance of 200 metres with 4 crews racing at a time.
6. The start of each race involves arriving on the starting line on the command "Ready - set - Go", and participants will start rowing on the word GO.
7. Every crew will take to the water approximately 10 minutes before the start of their race. Additionally, every crew should turn up on the pier at least 10 minutes before taking to the water.
8. Races will start every 15 minutes.

For safety reasons - only those participants entering and leaving their boats may have access to the pier (from where participants take to the water).
General Plan for the competition:

1. A technical briefing will take place on 20.04.2015 at $\mathbf{9 . 3 0}$.
2. The first race is planned for $\mathbf{1 0 . 0 0}$.

## The manner of conducting the regatta:

The organiser of the regatta provides the boats, along with equipment and coxes, life guard services for the competition, and life jackets, which must be worn by all participants.

## Final provisions:

The competition will be managed by judges of the Polish Canoe Federation. In the event of any dispute, the judge's decision is final and not subject to discussion.
PLEASE NOTE! Participants should bring bottled water and an extra set of dry clothes.
